Good luck to all those involved in sport this week. Remember to play hard but fair and do your best.

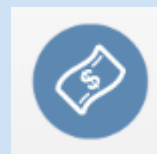

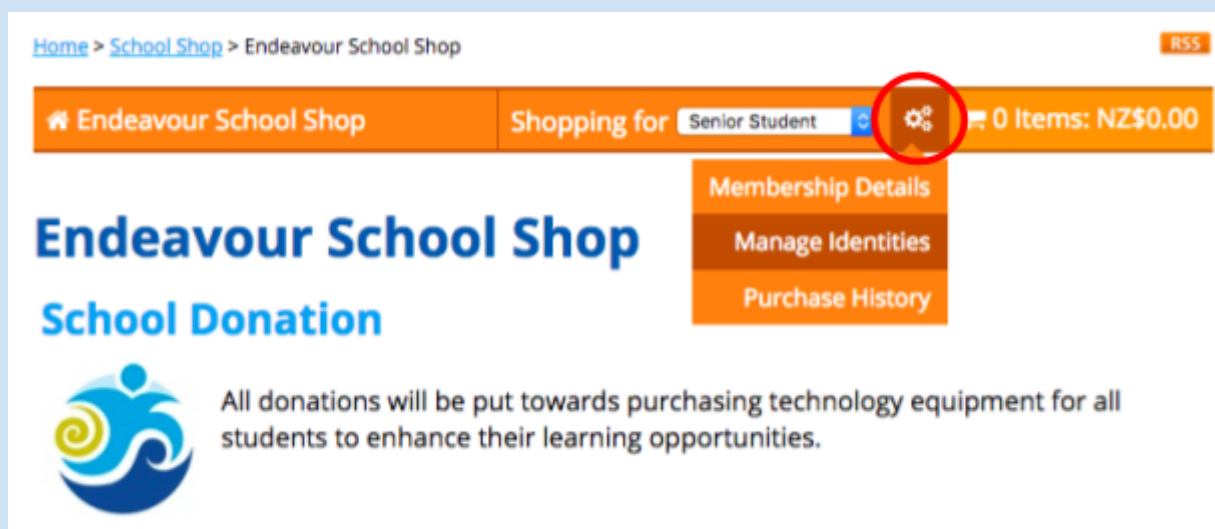
### Online Shop

Thank you to those who have paid for their 2018 Digital Technology Fee already. This fee allows us to continue use of the Maths Buddy programme for all students, as well as our new online parent portal, LincED. You can log-in to the shop at any time to pay for these costs and you will also now see the Term 3 donation option is available.

If you are unsure whether you have paid for anything in particular, you can now check via LincED - select MENU then the dollar image (pictured right). Alternatively, you can check past payments within the online shop in your Purchase History (pictured below).



This is also a great time to check your child's details are loaded correctly within the online shop by selecting 'Manage Identities'; this screen should show your child's name/s (not yours) and their Ako Group. We find a lot of parent names on this screen which makes processing payments very tricky if we are unsure which student it relates to.

Congratulations to Leila, Taylor and Mingyu who won our 'Design a Bookbag' Library competition last term.

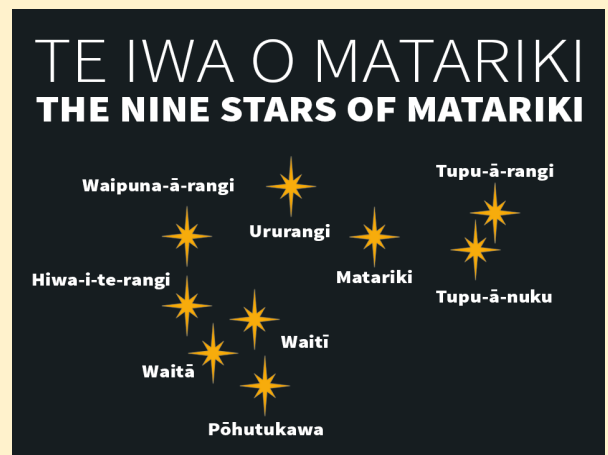
They each took home an awesome prize of a backpack that they could colour in at home.
