CODE OF CONDUCT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Rationale:

The Endeavour School International Student Code of Conduct clearly outlines the behavioral expectations for International Students during and outside of school hours.

School Rules :

Demonstrate Respect to staff , students and school rules at all times

Unacceptable social behaviour includes;

Physical: punching, hitting, kicking, excessive force, spitting, biting, poking, tripping, pulling hair or any other behaviour that puts children at risk.

Emotional: teasing, swearing, bullying, ostracising, group conflict, threats or any other emotionally harmful, upsetting behaviour.

Other: including but not limited to - theft, non-compliance, truancy, vandalism

I will be polite and respectful to all members of my host family
When I am unhappy or have any concerns I can speak to the Director of International Students.
